# A BILL

To provide for duty-free treatment of certain recreational performance outerwear, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "United States Optimal
- 5 Use of Trade to Develop Outerwear and Outdoor Recre-
- 6 ation Act" or the "U.S. OUTDOOR Act".
- 7 SEC. 2. FINDINGS.
- 8 Congress finds the following:

- 1 (1) The outdoor industry contributes 2 \$730,000,000,000 to the United States economy an-3 nually.
  - (2) Outdoor activities are vitally important to the health and well-being of the people of the United States.
  - (3) Duty rates on recreational performance apparel are among the highest duty rates imposed by the United States Government, with duties on some recreational performance apparel as high as 28.2 percent.
  - (4) The duties currently imposed by the United States on recreational performance apparel were set in an era during which high rates of duty were intended to protect the production of other apparel in the United States, and before the technologies and innovations that create today's recreational performance apparel industry were developed.
  - (5) In July 2007, the International Trade Commission confirmed in USITC Publication 3937 that recreational performance apparel produced in the United States makes up less than 1 percent of the total recreational performance apparel market and therefore concluded that there is no commercially

- viable production of recreational performance apparel in the United States.
- (6) On November 1, 2005, the Committee for the Implementation of Textile Agreements confirmed in the Federal Register that imports of certain recreational performance apparel do not contribute to domestic market disruption or adversely affect United States textile and apparel producers (70 Fed.
- 10 (7) The elimination of duties on the importation 11 of certain recreational performance apparel would 12 provide an economic benefit to United States con-13 sumers of outdoor products and would promote in-14 creased participation in healthy and active lifestyles.

### 15 SEC. 3. KNIT APPAREL AND ACCESSORIES.

- 16 (a) Definitions.—The Additional U.S. Note to

- 1 pants, and ski or snowboard pants intended for sale as
- 2 parts of ski-suits), coveralls and bib overalls, and jackets
- 3 (including, but not limited to, full zip jackets, paddling
- 4 jackets, ski jackets, and ski jackets intended for sale as
- 5 parts of ski-suits), windbreakers, and similar articles (in-
- 6 cluding padded, sleeveless jackets) predominately com-
- 7 posed of knit fabrics of cotton, wool, hemp, bamboo, silk,
- 8 or manmade fiber, or a combination of such fibers, that
- 9 are either water-resistant or visibly coated, or both, with
- 10 critically sealed seams, and with 5 or more of the following
- 11 features:
- "(i) Insulation for cold weather protection.
- 13 "(ii) Pockets, at least one of which has a 14 zippered, hook and loop, or other type of closure.
- 15 "(iii) Elastic, drawcord, or other means of 16 tightening around the waist or leg hems, including
- 17 hidden leg sleeves with a means of tightening at the
- ankle for trousers and tightening around the waist
- or bottom hem for jackets.
- 20 "(iv) Venting, not including grommet(s).
- 21 "(v) Articulated elbows or knees.
- 22 "(vi) Reinforcement in one of the following
- areas: the elbows, shoulders, seat, knees, or ankles
- or cuffs.

- "(vii) Weatherproof closure at the waist or 1 2 front. 3 "(viii) Multi-adjustable hood or adjustable collar. "(ix) Adjustable powder skirt, inner protective
- 6 skirt, or adjustable inner protective cuff at sleeve 7 hem.
- "(x) Construction at the arm gusset that uti-8 9 lizes fabric, design, or patterning to allow radial arm 10 movement.
- 11 "(xi) Odor control technology.
- 12 The term 'recreational performance outerwear' does not
- include occupational outerwear or garments with an outer 13
- 14 surface predominantly of looped pile.
- 15 "(b) For purposes of this Note, the following terms have the following meanings: 16
- "(i) The term 'water-resistant' means that a 17 18 garment must have a water resistance (see ASTM 19 designations D 3779-81 and D 7017) such that, 20 under a head pressure of 600 millimeters, not more 21 than 1.0 gram of water penetrates after two minutes 22 when tested in accordance with the current version
- 23 of AATCC Test Method 35. The water resistance of
- 24 the garment is the result of a rubber or plastics ap-
- 25 plication to the outer shell, lining, or inner lining.

1	"(ii) The term 'visibly coated' refers to fabric
2	that is impregnated, coated, covered, or laminated
3	with plastics, such as fabrics described in Note 2 to
4	chapter 59.
5	"(iii) The term 'sealed seams' means seams
6	that have been covered by means of taping, gluing,
7	bonding, cementing, fusing, welding, or a similar
8	process so that water cannot pass through the seams
9	when tested in accordance with the current version
10	of AATCC Test Method 35.
11	"(iv) The term 'critically sealed seams'
12	means—
13	"(A) for jackets, sealed seams that are
14	sealed at the front and back yokes, or at the
15	shoulders, arm holes, or both, where applicable;
16	and
17	"(B) for trousers, sealed seams that are
18	sealed at the front (up to the zipper or other
19	means of closure) and back rise.
20	"(v) The term 'insulation for cold weather pro-
21	tection' means insulation with either synthetic fill,
22	down, a laminated thermal backing, or other lining
23	for thermal protection from cold weather.
24	"(vi) The term 'venting' refers to closeable or
25	permanent constructed openings in a garment (ex-

cluding front, primary zipper closures and grommet(s)) to allow increased expulsion of built-up heat during outdoor activities. In a jacket, such openings are often positioned on the underarm seam of a garment but may also be placed along other seams in the front or back of a garment. In trousers, such openings are often positioned on the inner or outer leg seams of a garment but may also be placed along other seams in the front or back of a garment.

"(vii) The term 'articulated elbows or knees' refers to the construction of a sleeve (or pant leg) to allow improved mobility at the elbow (or knee) through the use of extra seams, darts, gussets, or other means.

"(viii) The term 'reinforcement' refers to the use of a double layer of fabric or section(s) of fabric that is abrasion-resistant or otherwise more durable than the predominant or face fabric of the garment.

"(ix) The term 'weatherproof closure' means a closure (including, but not limited to, laminated or coated zippers, storm flaps, or other weatherproof construction) that has been reinforced or engineered in a manner to reduce the penetration or absorption of moisture or air through an opening in the garment.

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- "(x) The term 'multi-adjustable hood or adjustable collar' means a draw cord, adjustment tab, or elastic incorporated into the hood or collar construction to allow volume adjustments around a helmet, the crown of the head, neck, or face.
  - "(xi) The terms 'adjustable powder skirt' and 'inner protective skirt' refer to a partial lower inner lining with means of tightening around the waist for additional protection from the elements.
  - "(xii) The term 'arm gusset' means construction at the arm of a gusset that utilizes an extra fabric piece in the under arm usually diamond- or triangular-shaped, design, or pattern to allow radial arm movement.
  - "(xiii) The term 'radial arm movement' refers to unrestricted, 180-degree range of motion for the arm while wearing performance outerwear.
  - "(xiv) The term 'odor control technology' means an additive in a fabric or garment capable of adsorbing, absorbing, or reacting with human odors, or effective in reducing odor-causing bacteria, including but not limited to activated carbon, silver, copper, or any combination thereof.
- 24 "(xv) The term 'occupational outerwear' means 25 outerwear garments, including uniforms, designed or

- 1 marketed for use in the workplace or at a worksite
- 2 to provide durable protection from cold or inclement
- 3 weather and/or workplace hazards, such as fire, elec-
- 4 trical, abrasion, or chemical hazards, or impacts,
- 5 cuts, punctures, or similar hazards.
- 6 "3. For purposes of this chapter, the importer of
- 7 record shall specify upon entry whether garments claimed
- 8 as recreational performance outerwear have an outer sur-
- 9 face that is water-resistant, visibly coated, or a combina-
- 10 tion thereof, and shall further enumerate the specific fea-
- 11 tures that make the garments eligible to be classified as
- 12 recreational performance outerwear.".

1 "(ii) Pockets, at least one of which has a 2 zippered, hook and loop, or other type of closure. 3 "(iii) Elastic, drawcord, or other means of 4 tightening around the waist or leg hems, including 5 hidden leg sleeves with a means of tightening at the 6 ankle for trousers and tightening around the waist 7 or bottom hem for jackets. "(iv) Venting, not including grommet(s). 8 "(v) Articulated elbows or knees. 9 "(vi) Reinforcement in one of the following 10 11 areas: the elbows, shoulders, seat, knees, or ankles 12 or cuffs. 13 "(vii) Weatherproof closure at the waist or 14 front. "(viii) Multi-adjustable hood or adjustable col-15 16 lar. "(ix) Adjustable powder skirt, inner protective 17 18 skirt, or adjustable inner protective cuff at sleeve 19 hem. 20 "(x) Construction at the arm gusset that uti-21 lizes fabric, design, or patterning to allow radial arm 22 movement. "(xi) Odor control technology. 23 The term 'recreational performance outerwear' does not

include occupational outerwear.

- 1 "(b) For purposes of this Note, the following terms 2 have the following meanings:
- 3 "(i) The term 'water-resistant' means that a 4 garment must have a water resistance (see ASTM 5 designations D 3779–81 and D 7017) such that, 6 under a head pressure of 600 millimeters, not more 7 than 1.0 gram of water penetrates after two minutes when tested in accordance with the current version 8 9 of AATCC Test Method 35. The water resistance of 10 the garment is the result of a rubber or plastics ap-11 plication to the outer shell, lining, or inner lining.
  - "(ii) The term 'visibly coated' refers to fabric that is impregnated, coated, covered, or laminated with plastics, such as fabrics described in Note 2 to chapter 59.
  - "(iii) The term 'sealed seams' means seams that have been covered by means of taping, gluing, bonding, cementing, fusing, welding, or a similar process so that water cannot pass through the seams when tested in accordance with the current version of AATCC Test Method 35.
  - "(iv) The term 'critically sealed seams' means seams' that are sealed—

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- 1 "(A) for jackets, at the front and back 2 yokes, or at the shoulders, arm holes, or both, 3 where applicable; and
  - "(B) for trousers, at the front (up to the zipper or other means of closure) and back rise.
  - "(v) The term 'insulation for cold weather protection' means insulation with either synthetic fill, down, a laminated thermal backing, or other lining for thermal protection from cold weather.
  - "(vi) The term 'venting' refers to closeable or permanent constructed openings in a garment (excluding front, primary zipper closures and grommet(s)) to allow increased expulsion of built-up heat during outdoor activities. In a jacket, such openings are often positioned on the underarm seam of a garment but may also be placed along other seams in the front or back of a garment. In trousers, such openings are often positioned on the inner or outer leg seams of a garment but may also be placed along other seams in the front or back of a garment.
  - "(vii) The term 'articulated elbows or knees' refers to the construction of a sleeve (or pant leg) to allow improved mobility at the elbow (or knee) through the use of extra seams, darts, gussets, or other means.

- "(viii) The term 'reinforcement' refers to the use of a double layer of fabric or section(s) of fabric that is abrasion-resistant or otherwise more durable than the predominant or face fabric of the garment.
- "(ix) The term 'weatherproof closure' means a closure (including, but not limited to, laminated or coated zippers, storm flaps, or other weatherproof construction) that has been reinforced or engineered in a manner to reduce the penetration or absorption of moisture or air through an opening in the garment.
- "(x) The term 'multi-adjustable hood or adjustable collar' means a draw cord, adjustment tab, or elastic incorporated into the hood or collar construction to allow volume adjustments around a helmet, the crown of the head, neck, or face.
- "(xi) The terms 'adjustable powder skirt' and 'inner protective skirt' refer to a partial lower inner lining with means of tightening around the waist for additional protection from the elements.
- "(xii) The term 'arm gusset' means construction at the arm of a gusset that utilizes an extra fabric piece in the under arm usually diamond- or triangular- shaped, design, or pattern to allow radial arm movement.

1 "(xiii) The term 'radial arm movement' refers 2 to unrestricted, 180-degree range of motion for the 3 arm while wearing performance outerwear.

> "(xiv) The term 'odor control technology' means an additive in a fabric or garment capable of adsorbing, absorbing, or reacting with human odors, or effective in reducing odor-causing bacteria, including but not limited to activated carbon, silver, copper, or any combination thereof.

> "(xv) The term 'occupational outerwear' means outerwear garments, including uniforms, designed or marketed for use in the workplace or at a worksite to provide durable protection from cold or inclement weather and/or workplace hazards, such as fire, electrical, abrasion, or chemical hazards, or impacts, cuts, punctures, or similar hazards.

"4. For purposes of this chapter, the importer of record shall specify upon entry whether garments claimed as 'recreational performance outerwear' have an outer sur-face that is water-resistant, visibly coated, or a combination thereof, and shall further enumerate the specific features that make the garments eligible to be classified as recreational performance outerwear.".

- FUND.
- 9 (a) Establishment.—There is established in the
- 10 Treasury of the United States the Sustainable Textile and
- 11 Apparel Research Fund (in this section referred to as the
- 12 "STAR Fund").

1 (b) Deposits.—There shall be deposited into the 2 STAR Fund amounts equal to the fees collected on rec-3 reational performance outerwear under subsection (d).

### (c) Board of Directors.—

- (1) IN GENERAL.—The STAR Fund shall be administered by a board of directors (in this section referred to as the "Board") composed of 5 individuals familiar with the recreational performance outerwear textile and apparel industry, including the production of raw materials and the finished products thereof, who shall be appointed by the President.
- (2) Members.—Not less than 2 of the individuals appointed to the Board under paragraph (1) shall be representatives of entities involved in the production of fabrics or raw materials for use in recreational performance outerwear in the United States, and not less than 2 of such individuals shall be representatives of entities involved in the production of recreational performance outerwear that pay the fees imposed on the importation of such outerwear under subsection (d).
- (3) INELIGIBLE INDIVIDUALS.—The President may not appoint individuals to the Board under paragraph (1) who are representatives of entities not

1 involved in the production of recreational perform-2 ance outerwear, such as customs brokers, converters, 3 forwarders, or shippers. (d) Funding.— (1) Fee.—In addition to any other fee author-6 ized by law, the Secretary of the Treasury shall 7 charge and collect upon entry, or withdrawal from 8 warehouse for consumption, a fee of 1.5 percent of 9 the appraised value of imported garments (as deter-10 mined under section 402 of the Tariff Act of 1930 11 (19 U.S.C. 1401a)) that are classifiable under the 12 Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States as 13 recreational performance outerwear (as defined in 14 U.S. Note 2 to chapter 61 and U.S. Note 3 to chap-15 ter 62 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the 16 United States). 17 Exclusions.—The assessment of 18 under paragraph (1) shall not apply to imports of 19 recreational performance outerwear from the fol-20 lowing: 21 (A) Any country that is party to a free 22 trade agreement with the United States that— 23 (i) is in effect on the day before the 24 date of the enactment of this Act; or

#### (e) DISTRIBUTION.—

- (1) Quarterly distributions.—The Secretary of Commerce, upon a majority vote of the Board, taken annually, shall, not later than 60 days after the end of each calendar quarter, distribute amounts in the STAR Fund to one or more entities that the Board considers appropriate to use the funds in accordance with subsection (f).
- (2) ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS.—An entity may receive funds under paragraph (1) only if the entity—
  - (A) is an organization described in section 501(c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 that is exempt from tax under section 501(a) of such Code;
  - (B) is an organization having at least 10 years of experience providing applied research, technology development, and education to all parts of the textile and apparel supply chain, with a research capability demonstrated through past research programs involving supply chain management, product development, fit specifications, operations management, lean

1	manufacturing, or digital supply chain tech-
2	nologies on behalf of the textile and sewn prod-
3	ucts industries in the United States; and
4	(C) is comprised of members representing
5	the following segments of the supply chain:
6	(i) One or more of the following types
7	of producers: fiber, yarn, or fabric pro-
8	ducers in the United States.
9	(ii) Apparel producers in the United

13	(f) USE OF FUNDS.—Funds distributed under sub-
14	section (e) may be used only to conduct applied research,
15	development, and education activities to enhance the com-
16	petitiveness of businesses in the United States in clean,
17	eco-friendly apparel, other textile and apparel articles, and
18	sewn-product design and manufacturing.
19	(g) Requirements.—The Secretary of Commerce
20	may impose such requirements on the use of funds distrib-
21	uted under subsection (e) as the Secretary considers nec-
22	essary to ensure compliance with subsection (f), including
23	requiring reporting and assurances by the entities using
24	the funds.

- (h) REPORTS TO CONGRESS.—The Secretary of Com-1 merce shall submit to Congress a report, not later than April 1 of each year, explaining in detail how amounts in the STAR Fund were distributed under subsection (e) and used under subsection (f) during the preceding calendar 6 year. SEC. 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act and the amendments made by this Act— 8 9 (1) take effect on the 15th day after the date
- of the enactment of this Act; and 11 (2) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after such 15th 12 13 day.

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
