## AN ACT

To require the Secretary of Homeland Security to submit a report on cyber vulnerability disclosures, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Cyber Vulnerability
- 3 Disclosure Reporting Act".

### 4 SEC. 2. REPORT ON CYBER VULNERABILITIES.

- 5 (a) REPORT.—Not later than 240 days after the date
- 6 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Homeland
- 7 Security shall submit to the Committee on Homeland Se-
- 8 curity of the House of Representatives and the Committee
- 9 on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs of the
- 10 Senate a report that contains a description of the policies
- 11 and procedures developed for coordinating cyber vulner-
- 12 ability disclosures, in accordance with section 227(m) of
- 13 the Homeland Security Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 148(m)).
- 14 To the extent possible, such report shall include an annex
- 15 with information on instances in which such policies and
- 16 procedures were used to disclose cyber vulnerabilities in
- 17 the year prior to the date such report is required and,
- 18 where available, information on the degree to which such
- 19 information was acted upon by industry and other stake-
- 20 holders. Such report may also contain a description of how
- 21 the Secretary is working with other Federal entities and
- 22 critical infrastructure owners and operators to prevent, de-
- 23 tect, and mitigate cyber vulnerabilities.

- 1 (b) FORM.—The report required under subsection (b)
- 2 shall be submitted in unclassified form but may contain
- 3 a classified annex.
