Mr. STUTZMAN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the  
Committee on Appropriations

## A BILL

To amend the Pay Our Military Act to provide funds for  
the operations of the National Guard.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Guard Appropriation  
5 Restoration During Shutdown Act” or “GARDS Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS TO COVER NA-**  
7 **TIONAL GUARD PERSONNEL AND OPER-**  
8 **ATIONAL COSTS.**

9 Section 2 of the Pay Our Military Act (HR 3210 of  
10 the 113th Congress) is amended—

1           (1) in subsection (a)(1), by inserting before the  
2           semicolon the following: “or, in the case of members  
3           of the National Guard, who perform inactive-duty  
4           training or other service during such period for  
5           which the members would otherwise be entitled to  
6           pay and allowances”;

7           (2) in subsection (a)(2), by inserting before the  
8           semicolon the following: “or, without regard to any  
9           such determination, are civilian personnel of the Na-  
10          tional Guard, including military technicians (dual  
11          status)”;

12          (3) by redesignating subsection (b) as sub-  
13          section (c) and inserting after subsection (a) the fol-  
14          lowing new subsection:

15          “(b) NATIONAL GUARD OPERATIONS.—There are  
16          hereby appropriated for fiscal year 2014, out of any money  
17          in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for any period  
18          during which interim or full-year appropriations for fiscal  
19          year 2014 are not in effect, such sums as are necessary  
20          to provide for the operation and maintenance of the Na-  
21          tional Guard, including necessary sums to prevent any  
22          interruption or delay in the performance by the National  
23          Guard of domestic disaster relief and recovery oper-  
24          ations.”.
