AN ACT

To recognize the Margaret Woodbury Strong Museum in
Rochester, New York.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “National Museum of
3 Play Recognition Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF NATIONAL MUSEUM OF PLAY IN**
5 **ROCHESTER, NEW YORK.**

6 (a) CONGRESSIONAL RECOGNITION.—Congress—

7 (1) recognizes that the Margaret Woodbury
8 Strong Museum, DBA Strong Museum, located in
9 Rochester, New York, is the only museum of its kind
10 that exists for the exclusive purpose of exploring the
11 ways in which play encourages learning, creativity,
12 and discovery, and how it illuminates cultural his-
13 tory; and

14 (2) officially designates the Margaret Woodbury
15 Strong Museum as the National Museum of Play.

16 (b) EFFECT OF RECOGNITION; DESIGNATION.—The
17 National Museum of Play recognized in subsection (a) is
18 not a unit of the National Park System and the designa-
19 tion under subsection (a) shall not be construed to require
20 or permit Federal funds to be expended for any purpose
21 related to the Museum.
