## A BILL

Making continuing appropriations for the compensation of Federal employees and certain military personnel in the event of a Government shutdown, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

**3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Military and Federal  
5 Civilian Employee Pay Act”.

1       **SEC. 2. CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS FOR FEDERAL EM-**  
2                   **PLOYEES AND CERTAIN MILITARY PER-**  
3                   **SONNEL.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—There are hereby appropriated for  
5   fiscal year 2014, out of any money in the Treasury not  
6   otherwise appropriated, for any period during which in-  
7   terim or full-year appropriations for fiscal year 2014 are  
8   not in effect such sums as are necessary to provide the  
9   pay and allowances for—

- 10              (1) Federal employees;  
11              (2) members of the reserve components of the  
12   Armed Forces (as named in section 10101 of title  
13   10, United States Code) who perform inactive-duty  
14   training (as defined in section 101(d)(7) of such  
15   title) during such period;  
16              (3) the commissioned corps of the Public  
17   Health Service; and  
18              (4) the commissioned corps of the National  
19   Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration.

20       (b) BACK PAY FOR FURLoughed INDIVIDUALS.—  
21   Any individual who will receive pay and allowances under  
22   subsection (a) but who was furloughed as a result of any  
23   lapse in appropriations which begins on or about October  
24   1, 2013, and ending on the date of enactment of this Act  
25   shall be compensated at their standard rate of compensa-

1 tion, for the period of such lapse in appropriations, as soon  
2 as practicable after such lapse in appropriations ends.

3 **SEC. 3. RECONCILIATION OF EXPENDITURES.**

4 Expenditures made pursuant to this Act shall be  
5 charged to the applicable appropriation, fund, or author-  
6 ization whenever a bill in which such applicable appropria-  
7 tion, fund, or authorization is contained is enacted into  
8 law.

9 **SEC. 4. TERMINATION.**

10 No part of any appropriation contained in this Act  
11 shall remain available for obligation beyond September 30,  
12 2014.
