Mr. GOMEZ introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To provide a set-aside of funds for Indian populations under the health profession opportunity grant program under section 2008 of the Social Security Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Tribal Healthcare Ca-
5 reers Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. SET-ASIDE OF FUNDS FOR INDIAN POPULATIONS.**

7 Section 2008(c)(1) of the Social Security Act (42
8 U.S.C. 1397g(c)(1)) is amended by inserting “15 percent

1 of which for each fiscal year shall be reserved for grants
2 to Indian tribes, tribal organizations, and Tribal Colleges
3 and Universities” before the period.

4 **SEC. 3. GUARANTEE OF GRANTS FOR INDIAN POPU-**
5 **LATIONS.**

6 Section 2008(a)(2)(C) of the Social Security Act (42
7 U.S.C. 1397(a)(2)(C)) is amended to read as follows:

8 “(C) GUARANTEE OF GRANTS FOR INDIAN
9 POPULATIONS.—The Secretary shall award at
10 least 10 grants under this subsection to an eli-
11 gible entity that is an Indian tribe, a tribal or-
12 ganization, or a Tribal College or University, to
13 the extent there are a sufficient number of ap-
14 plications submitted by such an eligible entity
15 that meet the requirements of subparagraph
16 (B).”.

17 **SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

18 The amendments made by this Act shall take effect
19 on October 1, 2019.

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
