- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Tribal Healthcare Ca-
- 5 reers Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. SET-ASIDE OF FUNDS FOR INDIAN POPULATIONS.
- 7 Section 2008(c)(1) of the Social Security Act (42
- 8 U.S.C. 1397g(c)(1)) is amended by inserting "15 percent

- 1 of which for each fiscal year shall be reserved for grants
- 2 to Indian tribes, tribal organizations, and Tribal Colleges
- 3 and Universities" before the period.
- 4 SEC. 3. GUARANTEE OF GRANTS FOR INDIAN POPU-
- 5 LATIONS.
- 6 Section 2008(a)(2)(C) of the Social Security Act (42
- 7 U.S.C. 1397(a)(2)(C)) is amended to read as follows:
- 8 "(C) Guarantee of grants for indian
- 9 POPULATIONS.—The Secretary shall award at
- least 10 grants under this subsection to an eli-
- gible entity that is an Indian tribe, a tribal or-
- ganization, or a Tribal College or University, to
- the extent there are a sufficient number of ap-
- plications submitted by such an eligible entity
- that meet the requirements of subparagraph
- 16 (B).".
- 17 SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- The amendments made by this Act shall take effect
- 19 on October 1, 2019.
