## A BILL

To provide for technical assistance under the health profession opportunity grant program under section 2008 of the Social Security Act.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Technical Assistance
- 5 for Health Grants Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.
- 7 (a) In General.—Section 2008 of the Social Secu-
- 8 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 1397) is amended—
- 9 (1) in subsection (b)(4), by striking subpara-
- 10 graph (D); and

1	(2) by redesignating subsections (c) and (d) as
2	subsections (d) and (e) and inserting after sub-
3	section (b) the following:
4	"(c) TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.—
5	"(1) In general.—The Secretary shall provide
6	technical assistance—
7	"(A) to assist eligible entities in applying
8	for grants under this section;
9	"(B) that is tailored to meet the needs of
10	grantees at each stage of the administration of
11	projects for which grants are made under this
12	section;
13	"(C) that is tailored to meet the specific
14	needs of Indian tribes tribal organizations, and
15	tribal colleges and universities;
16	"(D) that is tailored to meet the specific
17	needs of the territories;
18	"(E) that is tailored to meet the specific
19	needs of eligible entities in carrying out dem-
20	onstration projects for which a grant is made
21	under this section; and
22	"(F) to facilitate the exchange of informa-
23	tion among eligible entities regarding best prac-
24	tices and promising practices used in the
25	projects.

1	"(2) Continuation of Peer Technical As-
2	SISTANCE CONFERENCES.—The Secretary shall hold
3	peer technical assistance conferences for entities to
4	which a grant is made under this section.

- "(3) Report to the Congress.—During each Congress, the Secretary shall submit to the Committee on Ways and Means of the House of Representatives and the Committee on Finance of the Senate a report on the nature of any technical assistance provided to grantees under this section.".
- 11 (b) Funding.—Section 2008(c)(1) of such Act (42)
- 12 U.S.C. 1397(c)(1)) is amended by inserting ", and to
- 13 carry out subsection (c) \$15,000,000 for fiscal year 2020"
- 14 before the period.
