1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

5	SEC. 2. USE OF BLOCKED ASSETS TO SATISFY JUDGMENTS

8	Section 201(d) of the Terrorism Risk Insurance Act
9	of 2002 (28 U.S.C. 1610 note) is amended—
10	(1) in paragraph (2)—
11	(A) in the matter preceding subparagraph
12	(A), by striking "means";
13	(B) by amending paragraph (2)(A) to read
14	as follows:
15	"(A) means any asset seized or frozen by

18	5(b)), under sections 202 and 203 of the Inter-
19	national Emergency Economic Powers Act (50

22	(21 U.S.C. 1904(b)); and";

25	(3) by inserting after paragraph (3) the fol-
