## A BILL

To amend the Energy Policy Act of 2005 to require reporting relating to certain cost-share requirements, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Cost-Share Account-  
5 ability Act of 2023”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.**

7 Section 988 of the Energy Policy Act of 2005 (42  
8 U.S.C. 16352) is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
9 lowing new subsection:

1       “(g) REPORTING.—Not later than 120 days after the  
2 date of the enactment of this subsection and at least quar-  
3 terly thereafter, the Secretary shall submit to the Com-  
4 mittee on Science, Space, and Technology and Committee  
5 on Appropriations of the House of Representatives and the  
6 Committee on Energy and Natural Resources and the  
7 Committee on Appropriations of the Senate, and shall  
8 make publicly available, a report on the use by the Depart-  
9 ment during the period covered by the report of the au-  
10 thority to reduce or eliminate cost-sharing requirements  
11 provided by subsection (b)(3) or (c)(2).”.
