A BILL

To authorize the Fair Housing Commemorative Foundation to establish a commemorative work on Federal land in the District of Columbia to commemorate the enactment of the Fair Housing Act in 1968.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COMMEMORATIVE WORK RECOGNIZING EN-**
4 **ACTMENT OF FAIR HOUSING ACT.**

5 (a) AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH COMMEMORATIVE
6 WORK.—The Fair Housing Commemorative Foundation
7 may establish a commemorative work on Federal land in
8 the District of Columbia and its environs to commemorate

1 the enactment of the Fair Housing Act (title VIII of Pub-
2 lic Law 90–284) on April 11, 1968.

3 (b) COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COMMEMO-
4 RATIVE WORKS.—The commemorative work authorized by
5 subsection (a) shall be established in accordance with
6 chapter 89 of title 40, United States Code (commonly
7 known as the “Commemorative Works Act”).

8 (c) USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS PROHIBITED.—Federal
9 funds may not be used to pay any expense of the establish-
10 ment of the commemorative work authorized by subsection
11 (a). The Fair Housing Commemorative Foundation shall
12 be solely responsible for acceptance of contributions for,
13 and payment of the expenses of, the establishment of the
14 commemorative work.

15 (d) DEPOSIT OF EXCESS FUNDS.—If, upon payment
16 of all expenses of the establishment of the commemorative
17 work authorized by subsection (a) (including the mainte-
18 nance and preservation amount provided for in section
19 8906(b), of title 40, United States Code), or upon expira-
20 tion of the authority for the commemorative work under
21 chapter 89 of title 40, United States Code, there remains
22 a balance of funds received for the establishment of that
23 commemorative work, the Fair Housing Commemorative
24 Foundation shall transmit the amount of the balance to

1 the Secretary of the Treasury for deposit in the account
2 provided for in section 8906(b)(1) of such title.

3 (e) DEFINITIONS.—For the purposes of this section,
4 the terms “commemorative work” and “the District of Co-
5 lumbia and its environs” have the meanings given to such
6 terms in section 8902(a) of title 40, United States Code.
