Mr. ROHRBACHER (for himself and Mrs. MIMI WALTERS of California) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Defense to provide for the inclusion of the names of certain members of the Armed Forces on the Vietnam Veterans Memorial.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INCLUSION OF CERTAIN NAMES ON THE VIET-**
4 **NAM VETERANS MEMORIAL.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense shall
6 provide for the inclusion on the Vietnam Veterans Memo-
7 rial in the District of Columbia of the names of those
8 members of the Armed Forces who died in transit to or
9 from a covered combat zone during the Vietnam conflict,

1 including such members who died in the Loma Ridge
2 plane crash in California that occurred on June 25, 1965.

3 (b) DEFINITIONS.—For purposes of this Act:

4 (1) COVERED COMBAT ZONE.—The term “cov-
5 ered combat zone” means the combat zone defined
6 by Executive Order No. 11216, signed by President
7 Lyndon B. Johnson on April 24, 1965, and any sub-
8 sequent expansion of such zone.

9 (2) VIETNAM CONFLICT.—The term “Vietnam
10 conflict” has the meaning given such term in section
11 1035 of title 10, United States Code.

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
