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## A BILL

To establish certain remedies for certain individuals involuntarily separated from the Armed Forces solely on the basis of refusing to receive vaccinations against COVID–19.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Reinstate Our Troops  
5       Act”.

1   **SEC. 2. CERTAIN REMEDIES FOR CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS IN-**  
2                 **VOLUNTARILY SEPARATED FROM THE**  
3                 **ARMED FORCES SOLELY ON THE BASIS OF**  
4                 **REFUSING TO RECEIVE VACCINATIONS**  
5                 **AGAINST COVID-19.**

6         (a) REINSTATEMENT.—

7                 (1) ELECTION.—At the election of a covered in-  
8                 dividual, the Secretary concerned shall reinstate the  
9                 covered individual as a member of the Armed Force  
10                 concerned, in the same rank and grade the covered  
11                 individual held at the time of separation from such  
12                 Armed Force.

13                 (2) DEADLINES.—A covered individual may  
14                 make an election under this subsection during the  
15                 one-year period following the date of the enactment  
16                 of this Act. The Secretary concerned shall reinstate  
17                 a covered individual who makes such an election not  
18                 later than 30 days after such election.

19         (b) BONUSES FOR REINSTATED OR REENLISTED IN-  
20                 DIVIDUALS.—In the case of a covered individual who  
21                 makes an election under subsection (a):

22                 (1) ENLISTED MEMBERS.—

23                 (A) INAPPLICABILITY OF REPAYMENT PRO-  
24                 VISION.—Subsection (g) of section 331 of title  
25                 37, United States Code, shall not apply to such  
26                 an individual who fails to complete a period of

1           service as a member of an Armed Force solely  
2           because such individual was a covered indi-  
3           vidual.

4                 (B) RETURN OF REPAYED BONUS.—Not  
5           later than 30 days after an individual described  
6           in subparagraph (A) makes an election under  
7           subsection (a), the Secretary concerned shall re-  
8           turn to such individual a bonus paid under such  
9           section to such individual and repaid by such  
10          individual pursuant to such subsection (g) and  
11          section 373 of such title.

12                 (2) OFFICERS.—

13                 (A) INAPPLICABILITY OF REPAYMENT PRO-  
14           VISION.—Subsection (f) of section 332 of title  
15           37, United States Code, shall not apply to such  
16           an individual who fails to complete a period of  
17           service as a member of an Armed Force solely  
18           because such individual was a covered indi-  
19           vidual.

20                 (B) RETURN OF REPAYED BONUS.—Not  
21           later than 30 days after an individual described  
22           in subparagraph (A) makes an election under  
23           subsection (a), the Secretary concerned shall re-  
24           turn to such individual a bonus paid under such  
25           section to such individual and repaid by such

1           individual pursuant to such subsection (f) and  
2           section 373 of such title.

3        (c) RETROACTIVE CHARACTERIZATIONS OF DIS-  
4 CHARGE.—In the case of a covered individual who does  
5 not make an election under subsection (a), the Secretary  
6 concerned shall ensure that the discharge of such indi-  
7 vidual is characterized as honorable.

8        (d) EXPUNGEMENT OF ADVERSE ACTION.—The Sec-  
9 retary concerned shall expunge from the military service  
10 record of a covered individual any reference to adverse ac-  
11 tion against such individual solely on the basis of the re-  
12 fusal of such individual to receive a vaccination against  
13 COVID-19.

14       (e) REPORT.—Not later than 60 days after the date  
15 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense  
16 shall submit to the Committees on Armed Services of the  
17 Senate and House of Representatives a report on progress  
18 in carrying out this section.

19       (f) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

20           (1) The term “covered individual” means an in-  
21           dividual who—

22                   (A) as a member of an Armed Force, re-  
23                   quested an exemption from an order to receive  
24                   a vaccination against COVID-19; and

1                   (B) was involuntarily separated from an  
2                   Armed Force solely on the basis of the refusal  
3                   of such individual to receive such a vaccination.

4                   (2) The term “Secretary concerned” has the  
5                   meaning given such term in section 101 of title 10,  
6                   United States Code.

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
