A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to complete a special resource study to determine the suitability and feasibility of adding the birthplace site to the Harry S Truman National Historic Site or designating the site as a separate unit of the National Park System, and for other purposes.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Harry S Truman
- 5 Birthplace Study Act".

SEC. 2. SPECIAL RESOURCE STUDY.
