To amend title 10, United States Code, to exempt members of the Armed Forces who voluntarily separate from active duty and incur a service-connected disability after being recalled to active duty from the requirement to repay voluntary separation pay.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Recalled Veterans Pro-
5 tection Act of 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXEMPTION FROM REPAYMENT OF VOLUNTARY**
2 **SEPARATION PAY.**

3 Section 1175a(j) of title 10, United States Code, is
4 amended—

5 (1) in paragraph (1) by striking “paragraphs
6 (2) and (3)” and inserting “paragraphs (2), (3), and
7 (4)”;

8 (2) by redesignating paragraph (4) as para-
9 graph (5); and

10 (3) by inserting after paragraph (3) the fol-
11 lowing new paragraph:

12 “(4) This subsection shall not apply to a member
13 who—

14 “(A) is involuntarily recalled to active duty or
15 full-time National Guard duty; and

16 “(B) in the course of such duty, incurs a serv-
17 ice-connected disability (as defined in section 101 of
18 title 38, United States Code).”.

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
