A BILL

To extend the availability of funds for Emergency Assistance to Non-Public Schools under the Education Stabilization Fund and the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “EANS Extension Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. EXTENDING THE AVAILABILITY OF EANS FUNDS.**

6 (a) EANS I.—Notwithstanding any other provision
7 of law, any funds reserved under section 312(a)(2) of divi-
8 sion M of title III of the Consolidated Appropriations Act,
9 2021 (Public Law 116–260; 134 Stat. 1925) shall remain

1 available through September 30, 2023, and shall be sub-
2 ject to the requirements of section 421(b) of the General
3 Education Provisions Act (20 U.S.C. 1225(b)).

4 (b) EANS II.—

5 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 2002(a) of the
6 American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (Public Law
7 117–2; 135 Stat. 23) is amended by striking “2023”
8 and inserting “2024”.

9 (2) GEPA.—The amendment made by para-
10 graph (1) shall be subject to the requirements of
11 section 421(b) of the General Education Provisions
12 Act (20 U.S.C. 1225(b)).
