## A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to ensure that the retired pay benefits promised a person when they join the Armed Forces are not reduced.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Keeping Our Promises
- 5 Act of 2011".
- 6 SEC. 2. PROTECTION OF RETIRED PAY BENEFITS FOR CUR-
- 7 RENT MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES.
- 8 Section 1411 of title 10, United States Code, is
- 9 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
- 10 section:

1	"(c) No Reduction in Retired Pay Benefits
2	FOR CURRENT MEMBERS.—Notwithstanding the effective
3	date or specified applicability of any change regarding the
4	entitlement of members or former members of the armed
5	forces to retired or retainer pay under this title or to the
6	computation of such retired or retainer pay under the for-
7	mulas of the table in section 1401(a) of this title or of
8	any other provision of law, the change shall not apply to
9	a member or former member who first became a member
10	of the armed forces before the effective date of the change
11	unless—
12	"(1) the member or former member affirma-
13	tively accepts the change; or
14	"(2) the change would have the effect of ex-
15	panding the entitlement or eligibility of the member
16	or former member to retired or retainer pay or in-
17	creasing the amount of such retired or retainer
18	pay.''.
