To direct the Architect of the Capitol to fly the flag of a State over the Capitol each year on the anniversary of the date of the State's admission to the Union. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "State Admission Day5 Recognition Act of 2009".

6 SEC. 2. FLYING STATE FLAG OVER CAPITOL ON ANNIVER7 SARY OF STATE'S ADMISSION TO UNION.

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—To honor the anniversary of each 9 State's admission to the Union, the Architect of the Cap-10 itol shall fly the flag of the State over the Capitol each 11 year on the anniversary of the date of the State's admis-12 sion to the Union.

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The Architect of the Capitol
shall fly the first flag of a State over the Capitol under
this section on the first December 7 which occurs after
the date of the enactment of this Act, in honor of the anniversary of the admission of Delaware, the first State admitted to the Union.

19 SEC. 3. REGULATIONS.

The Committee on House Administration of the House of Representatives and the Committee on Rules and Administration of the Senate may promulgate jointly such regulations as may be appropriate to carry out this Act, including regulations permitting the Architect of the Capitol to honor the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico,

- 1 American Samoa, Guam, the United States Virgin Islands,
- 2 and the Northern Mariana Islands by flying the flag of each
- 3 such jurisdiction over the Capitol each year on an appro-
- 4 priate date for that jurisdiction.
