## A BILL

For the relief of Flavia Maboloc Cahoon.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 2 3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR FLAVIA 4 **MABOLOC CAHOON.** 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a) 6 and (b) of section 201, and section 245(d), of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Flavia Maboloc Cahoon shall 7 8 be eligible for issuance of an immigrant visa or for adjust-9 ment of status to that of an alien lawfully admitted for 10 permanent residence upon filing an application for

11 issuance of an immigrant visa under section 204 of such

Act or for adjustment of status to lawful permanent resi dent.

3 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—Notwithstanding 4 subsection (d) of section 245 of the Immigration and Na-5 tionality Act, if Flavia Maboloc Cahoon enters the United States before the filing deadline specified in subsection (c) 6 7 of this Act, she shall be considered to have entered and 8 remained lawfully and shall, if otherwise eligible, be eligi-9 ble for adjustment of status under such section 245 as 10 of the date of the enactment of this Act.

11 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF 12 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-13 plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the application for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees 14 15 within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act. 16 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.— 17 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent residence to Flavia Maboloc Cahoon, the Secretary of State 18 shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 1, during the 19 20current or next following fiscal year, the total number of 21 immigrant visas that are made available to natives of the 22 country of the alien's birth under section 203(a) of the 23 Immigration and Nationality Act or, if applicable, the 24 total number of immigrant visas that are made available

to natives of the country of the alien's birth under section
202(e) of such Act.

3 (e) Denial  $\mathbf{OF}$ Preferential **IMMIGRATION** TREATMENT FOR CERTAIN RELATIVES.—The natural 4 5 parents, brothers, and sisters of Flavia Maboloc Cahoon shall not, by virtue of such relationship, be accorded any 6 7 right, privilege, or status under the Immigration and Nationality Act. 8
