A BILL

To amend title II of the Social Security Act to protect the Social Security Trust Funds from overpayment discharge during bankruptcy proceedings, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Social Security Debt
5 Recovery Act of 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION OF THE TREATMENT OF OVERPAY-**
2 **MENTS.**

3 Section 207 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
4 407) is amended by adding at the end the following:

5 “(d)(1) The amount of any overpayment of benefits
6 to an individual under this title, and any obligation of the
7 individual to repay such overpayment, shall be determined
8 solely under this title.

9 “(2) No other provision of law, including title 11 of
10 the United States Code, may be construed to limit, super-
11 sede, or otherwise modify the provisions of this subsection
12 except to the extent that it does so by express reference
13 to this subsection.”.

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
