 Act of 1934 (47 U.S.C. 309(j)(8)(E)) shall remain avail able until expended, but not beyond September 30, 2012.

5 (b) The period for performance of any investment approved under the Program as of the date of enactment 6 7 of this Act shall be extended by one year, but not later 8 than September 30, 2011, except that the Assistant Sec-9 retary of Commerce for Communications and Information 10 may extend, on a case-by-case basis, the period of per-11 formance for any investment approved under the Program 12 as of that date for a period of not more than 2 years, 13 but not later than September 30, 2012. In making a determination as to whether an extension beyond September 14 15 30, 2011, is warranted, the Assistant Secretary should consider the circumstances that gave rise to the need for 16 17 the extension, the likelihood of completion of performance 18 within the deadline for completion, and such other factors 19 as the Assistant Secretary deems necessary to make the 20 determination.
