1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 3 nam Allies Long Overdue for Relief Act" or the "Korean
- 4 American VALOR Act".
- 5 SEC. 2. PROVISION OF CERTAIN BENEFITS TO INDIVIDUALS
- 6 WHO SERVED IN THE ARMED FORCES OF THE
- 7 REPUBLIC OF KOREA.
- 8 Section 109 of title 38, United States Code, is
- 9 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
- 10 section:
- " (d)(1) Any person described in paragraph (2) is eli-
- 12 gible for the benefits specified in subsection (a) to the
- 13 same extent and under the same conditions (including
- 14 with respect to applicable reciprocity requirements) as a
- 15 discharged member of the armed forces of a government
- 16 specified in such subsection who is eligible for such bene-
- 17 fits under such subsection.
- 18 "(2) A person described in this paragraph is a person
- 19 whom the Secretary determines served in Vietnam as a
- 20 member of the armed forces of the Republic of Korea at
- 21 any time during the period beginning on January 9, 1962,
- 22 and ending on May 7, 1975, or such other period as deter-

- 1 mined appropriate by the Secretary for purposes of this
- 2 subsection.".
