1 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO DENY OIL AND GAS LEASES**
2 **AND PERMITS TO PERSONS WHO ENGAGE IN**
3 **ACTIVITIES WITH CERTAIN FOREIGN COUN-**
4 **TRIES.**

5 Section 8(a) of the Outer Continental Shelf Lands
6 Act (43 U.S.C. 1337(a)) is amended by adding at the end
7 the following:

8 “(9) The Secretary may deny issuance of an oil and
9 gas lease under this Act, or a permit for exploration, devel-
10 opment, or production under such a lease, to any person
11 that has engaged in activities with the government of any
12 foreign country that is subject to any sanction or an em-
13 bargo established by the Government of the United States,
14 including any sanction or embargo established under sec-
15 tion 203 of the Emergency Economic Powers Act (50
16 U.S.C. 1702).”.
