A BILL

To allow for innovations and alternative technologies that
meet or exceed desired energy efficiency goals.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Enabling Energy Sav-
5 ing Innovations Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. INNOVATIVE COMPONENT TECHNOLOGIES.**

7 Section 342(f) of the Energy Policy and Conservation
8 Act (42 U.S.C. 6313(f)) is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “paragraphs
2 (2) through (5)” and inserting “paragraphs (2)
3 through (6)”; and

4 (2) by adding at the end the following new
5 paragraph:

6 “(6) INNOVATIVE COMPONENT TECH-
7 NOLOGIES.—Subparagraph (C) of paragraph (1)
8 shall not apply to a walk-in cooler or walk-in freezer
9 components if the manufacturer has demonstrated
10 to the satisfaction of the Secretary that the compo-
11 nent model reduces energy consumption at least as
12 much as if such subparagraph were to apply. In sup-
13 port of any demonstration under this paragraph, a
14 manufacturer shall provide to the Secretary all data
15 and technical information necessary to fully evaluate
16 its application.”.
