3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Extending Access to
5 Addiction Treatment Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENDING REQUIREMENT FOR STATE MEDICAID**
2 **PLANS TO PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR MEDICA-**
3 **TION-ASSISTED TREATMENT.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 1905(a)(29) of the Social
5 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396d(a)(29)) is amended by
6 striking “2025” and inserting “2035”.

7 (b) **CONFORMING AMENDMENT.**—Section
8 1006(b)(4)(A) of the Substance Use-Disorder Prevention
9 that Promotes Opioid Recovery and Treatment for Pa-
10 tients and Communities Act (42 U.S.C. 1396a note) is
11 amended by striking “2025” and inserting “2035”.
