AN ACT

- To amend title 38, United States Code, to establish in the Department of Veterans Affairs the Veterans Economic Opportunity and Transition Administration, and for other purposes.
- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans Economic3 Opportunity and Transition Administration Act".

4 SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF VETERANS ECONOMIC OPPOR-

- TUNITY AND TRANSITION ADMINISTRATION.
- 6 (a) VETERANS ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY AND TRAN7 SITION ADMINISTRATION.—

8 (1) IN GENERAL.—Part V of title 38, United
9 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the
10 following new chapter:

11 "CHAPTER 80—VETERANS ECONOMIC OP PORTUNITY AND TRANSITION ADMIN ISTRATION

"Sec.

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"8001. Organization of Administration. "8002. Functions of Administration.

"8003. Annual report to Congress.

14 "§ 8001. Organization of Administration

15 "(a) VETERANS ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY AND TRANSITION ADMINISTRATION.—There is in the Depart-16 17 ment of Veterans Affairs a Veterans Economic Oppor-18 tunity and Transition Administration. The primary func-19 tion of the Veterans Economic Opportunity and Transition Administration is the administration of the programs 20 21 of the Department that provide assistance related to eco-22 nomic opportunity to veterans and their dependents and 23 survivors.

1 "(b) UNDER SECRETARY FOR ECONOMIC OPPOR-2 TUNITY AND TRANSITION.—The Veterans Economic Op-3 portunity and Transition Administration is under the 4 Under Secretary for Veterans Economic Opportunity and 5 Transition, who is directly responsible to the Secretary for 6 the operations of the Administration.

7 "§ 8002. Functions of Administration

8 "The Veterans Economic Opportunity and Transition
9 Administration is responsible for the administration of the
10 following programs of the Department:

11 "(1) Vocational rehabilitation and employment12 programs.

13 "(2) Educational assistance programs.

14 "(3) Veterans' housing loan and related pro-15 grams.

16 "(4) The Transition Assistance Program under17 section 1144 of title 10.

18 "(5) Any other program of the Department19 that the Secretary determines appropriate.

20 "§ 8003. Annual report to Congress

21 "The Secretary shall include in the annual report to
22 the Congress required by section 529 of this title a report
23 on the programs administered by the Under Secretary for
24 Veterans Economic Opportunity and Transition. Each
25 such report shall include the following with respect to each

such program during the fiscal year covered by that re port:

3 "(1) The number of claims received. 4 "(2) The number of claims decided. "(3) The average processing time for a claim. 5 6 "(4) The number of successful outcomes (as de-7 termined by the Secretary). 8 "(5) The number of full-time equivalent em-9 ployees. "(6) The amounts expended for information 10 11 technology.". 12 (2) CLERICAL AMENDMENTS.—The tables of 13 chapters at the beginning of title 38, United States 14 Code, and of part V of title 38, United States Code, 15 are each amended by inserting after the item relating to chapter 79 the following new item: 16 "80. Veterans Economic Opportunity and Transition Administration 8001".

17 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Chapter 80 of title 38,
18 United States Code, as added by subsection (a), shall take
19 effect on October 1, 2025.

(c) FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES.—For fiscal years 2025
and 2026, the total number of full-time equivalent employees authorized for the Veterans Benefits Administration
and the Veterans Economic Opportunity and Transition
Administration, as established under chapter 80 of title

38, United States Code, as added by subsection (a), may
 not exceed—

- 3 (1) 34,228 in fiscal year 2025; and
- 4 (2) 35,417 in fiscal year 2026.

5 (d) LABOR RIGHTS.—Any labor rights, inclusion in the bargaining unit, and collective bargaining agreement 6 7 that affects an employee of the Department of Veterans 8 Affairs who is transferred to the Veterans Economic Op-9 portunity and Transition Administration, as established 10 under chapter 80 of title 38, United States Code, as added by subsection (a), shall apply in the same manner to such 11 12 employee after such transfer.

13 SEC. 3. UNDER SECRETARY FOR VETERANS ECONOMIC OP-

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PORTUNITY AND TRANSITION.

15 (a) UNDER SECRETARY.—

16 (1) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 3 of title 38, United
17 States Code, is amended by inserting after section
18 306 the following new section:

19 "§ 306A. Under Secretary for Veterans Economic Op 20 portunity and Transition

21 "(a) UNDER SECRETARY.—There is in the Depart22 ment an Under Secretary for Veterans Economic Oppor23 tunity and Transition, who is appointed by the President,
24 by and with the advice and consent of the Senate. The
25 Under Secretary for Veterans Economic Opportunity and

Transition shall be appointed without regard to political
 affiliation or activity and solely on the basis of dem onstrated ability in—

4 "(1) information technology; and

5 "(2) the administration of programs within the 6 Veterans Economic Opportunity and Transition Ad-7 ministration or programs of similar content and 8 scope.

9 "(b) RESPONSIBILITIES.—The Under Secretary for 10 Veterans Economic Opportunity and Transition is the 11 head of, and is directly responsible to the Secretary for 12 the operations of, the Veterans Economic Opportunity and 13 Transition Administration.

14 "(c) VACANCIES.—(1) Whenever a vacancy in the po-15 sition of Under Secretary for Veterans Economic Oppor-16 tunity and Transition occurs or is anticipated, the Sec-17 retary shall establish a commission to recommend individ-18 uals to the President for appointment to the position.

19 "(2) A commission established under this subsection20 shall be composed of the following members appointed by21 the Secretary:

"(A) Three persons representing education and
training, vocational rehabilitation, employment, real
estate, mortgage finance and related industries, and
survivor benefits activities affected by the Veterans

Economic Opportunity and Transition Administra tion.

3 "(B) Two persons representing veterans served
4 by the Veterans Economic Opportunity and Transi5 tion Administration.

6 "(C) Two persons who have experience in the 7 management of private sector benefits programs of 8 similar content and scope to the economic oppor-9 tunity and transition programs of the Department.

10 "(D) The Deputy Secretary of Veterans Affairs.
11 "(E) The chairman of the Veterans' Advisory
12 Committee on Education formed under section 3692
13 of this title.

"(F) One person who has held the position of
Under Secretary for Veterans Economic Opportunity
and Transition, if the Secretary determines that it
is desirable for such person to be a member of the
commission.

19 "(3) A commission established under this subsection 20 shall recommend at least three individuals for appoint-21 ment to the position of Under Secretary for Veterans Eco-22 nomic Opportunity and Transition. The commission shall 23 submit all recommendations to the Secretary. The Sec-24 retary shall forward the recommendations to the President 25 and the Committees on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and House of Representatives with any comments the Sec retary considers appropriate. Thereafter, the President
 may request the commission to recommend additional in dividuals for appointment.

5 "(4) The Assistant Secretary or Deputy Assistant 6 Secretary of Veterans Affairs who performs personnel 7 management and labor relations functions shall serve as 8 the executive secretary of a commission established under 9 this subsection.".

10 (2) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sec11 tions at the beginning of such chapter is amended

- 7 (10) in section 7703, by striking paragraphs (2)
 8 and (3) and redesignating paragraphs (4) and (5) as
 9 paragraphs (2) and (3), respectively.

(c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Section 306A of title 38,
United States Code, as added by subsection (a), and the
amendments made by this section, shall take effect on October 1, 2025.

14 SEC. 4. TRANSFER OF SERVICES.

15 (a) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Not later than 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary 16 17 of Veterans Affairs shall submit to the Committees on 18 Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and House of Representatives a report on the progress toward establishing the Vet-19 erans Economic Opportunity and Transition Administra-20 21 tion, as established under section 8001 of title 38, United 22 States Code, as added by section 2, and the transition of 23 the provision of services to veterans by such Administra-24 tion.

(b) CERTIFICATION.—The Secretary of Veterans Af-1 2 fairs may not transfer the function of providing any serv-3 ices to veterans to the Veterans Economic Opportunity 4 and Transition Administration, as established under sec-5 tion 8001 of title 38, United States Code, as added by 6 section 2, until the Secretary submits to the Committees 7 on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and House of Rep-8 resentatives certification that—

9 (1) the transition of the provision of services to
10 such Administration will not negatively affect the
11 provision of such services to veterans; and

12 (2) such services are ready to be transferred.

(c) DEADLINE FOR CERTIFICATION.—The Secretary
shall submit to the Committees on Veterans' Affairs of
the Senate and House of Representatives the certification
required by subsection (b)—

17 (1) no earlier than April 1, 2025; and

18 (2) no later than September 1, 2025.

(d) FAILURE TO CERTIFY.—If the Secretary fails to
submit the certification required by subsection (b) by the
date specified in subsection (c)(2), the Secretary shall submit to the Committees on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate
and House of Representatives a report that includes—

24 (1) the reason why the certification was not25 made by such date; and

(2) the estimated date when the certification
 will be made.

3 SEC. 5. MODIFICATION OF CERTAIN HOUSING LOAN FEES.

4 The loan fee table in section 3729(b)(2) of title 38,
5 United States Code, is amended by striking "November
6 15, 2031" each place it appears and inserting "December
7 27, 2031".
