2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Chronic Disease Flexi-
5 ble Coverage Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. SERVICES AND ITEMS FOR CHRONIC CONDITIONS**
2 **TREATED AS PREVENTIVE CARE.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—The additional preventive care
4 services and items for chronic conditions that may be
5 treated as preventive care for purposes of section
6 223(c)(2)(C) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as set
7 forth in IRS Notice 2019–45 shall have the same force
8 and effect as if included in the enactment of this Act.

9 (b) **NO INFERENCE.**—To the extent not inconsistent
10 with this subsection, no inference shall be made from such
11 subsection with respect to such other rules or guidance
12 as the Secretary has provided, or may provide, with re-
13 spect to preventive services for purposes of section
14 223(c)(2)(C) of such Code.

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
