3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Federal Infrastructure
5 Flood Resiliency Act of 2017”.

6 **SEC. 2. LEGAL EFFECT.**

7 Notwithstanding any other provision of law or Execu-
8 tive order, Executive Order 13690 (80 Fed. Reg. 6425),

1 signed on January 30, 2015, and entitled “Establishing
2 a Federal Flood Risk Management Standard and a Proc-
3 ess for Further Soliciting and Considering Stakeholder
4 Input” shall have the force and effect of law.
