A BILL

To provide for a lifetime National Recreational Pass for any veteran with a service-connected disability, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Wounded Veterans
5 Recreation Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. NATIONAL RECREATIONAL PASSES FOR DISABLED**
2 **VETERANS.**

3 Section 805(b)(2) of the Federal Lands Recreation
4 Enhancement Act (16 U.S.C. 6804(b)(2)) is amended as
5 follows:

6 (1) By inserting “and for the lifetime of the
7 passholder” after “without charge”.

8 (2) By striking “charge, to” and inserting
9 “charge, to the following:”.

10 (3) By striking “any United States” and insert-
11 ing the following:

12 “(A) Any United States”.

13 (4) By inserting after “residency.” the fol-
14 lowing:

15 “(B) Any veteran with a service-connected
16 disability, as defined in section 101 of title 38,
17 United States Code.”.

18 (5) By striking the last sentence.

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
