A BILL

To provide for the expiration of certain provisions of the USA PATRIOT Act and the FISA Amendments Act of 2008 on December 31, 2014.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Security
5 Agency Data Collection Review Act of 2014”.

1 **SEC. 2. SUNSET OF CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE USA PA-**
2 **TRIBUT ACT AND THE FISA AMENDMENTS ACT**
3 **OF 2008.**

4 (a) USA PATRIOT ACT.—Section 102(b)(1) of the
5 USA PATRIOT Improvement and Reauthorization Act of
6 2005 (Public Law 109–177; 50 U.S.C. 1805 note, 50
7 U.S.C. 1861 note, and 50 U.S.C. 1862 note) is amended
8 by striking “June 1, 2015” and inserting “December 31,
9 2014”.

10 (b) FISA AMENDMENTS ACT OF 2008.—

11 (1) SUNSET.—Section 403(b) of the FISA
12 Amendments Act of 2008 (Public Law 110–261; 50
13 U.S.C. 1801 note) is amended—

14 (A) in paragraph (1), by striking “Decem-
15 ber 31, 2017” and inserting “December 31,
16 2014”; and

17 (B) in paragraph (2) in the material pre-
18 ceding subparagraph (A), by striking “Decem-
19 ber 31, 2017” and inserting “December 31,
20 2014”.

21 (2) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—The heading
22 of section 404(b)(1) of the FISA Amendments Act
23 of 2008 (Public Law 110–261; 50 U.S.C. 1801
24 note) is amended by striking “DECEMBER 31, 2017”
25 and inserting “DECEMBER 31, 2014”.
