To amend the Communications Act of 1934 to promote the expansion of spectrum-based services to exceptionally hard-to-serve populations in unserved and underserved geographic locations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Promoting Rural
5 Broadband Act of 2014”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROMOTION OF SPECTRUM-BASED SERVICES IN**
2 **UNSERVED AND UNDERSERVED LOCATIONS.**

3 Section 309(j)(4) of the Communications Act of 1934
4 (47 U.S.C. 309(j)(4)) is amended—

5 (1) in subparagraph (E), by striking “and” at
6 the end;

7 (2) in subparagraph (F), by striking the period
8 at the end and inserting “; and”; and

9 (3) by adding at the end the following:

10 “(G) promote the expansion of spectrum-
11 based services to exceptionally hard-to-serve
12 populations in unserved and underserved geo-
13 graphic locations.”.
