A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on Cuprate
(4-).

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CUPRATE (4-).**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.02.63 of the Har-
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended
6 by striking “12/31/2006” and inserting “12/31/2014”.

7 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—

8 (1) IN GENERAL.—The amendment made by
9 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or with-
10 drawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
11 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.

1 (2) RETROACTIVE PROVISION.—Notwith-
2 standing section 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19
3 U.S.C. 1514) or any other provision of law, upon
4 proper request filed with U.S. Customs and Border
5 Protection on or before the 15th day after the date
6 of the enactment of this Act, any entry, or with-
7 drawal from warehouse for consumption, of an arti-
8 cle—

9 (A) that was made after December 31,
10 2006, and before the date that is 15 days after
11 the date of enactment of this Act, and

12 (B) with respect to which there would have
13 been no duty or a lower rate of duty if the
14 amendment made by subsection (a) applied to
15 such entry or withdrawal,
16 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as if such amend-
17 ment applied to such entry or withdrawal.
