## A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXPANSION OF AUTHORITY OF GOVERN-**  
2 **MENTAL SOCIAL SERVICE AGENCIES WITH**  
3 **CHILD PROTECTION RESPONSIBILITIES TO**  
4 **ACCESS THE NATIONAL CRIME INFORMATION**  
5 **DATABASES.**

6 Section 151(a)(2) of the Adam Walsh Child Protec-  
7 tion and Safety Act of 2006 (42 U.S.C. 16961(a)(2)) is  
8 amended by striking “, to be used by such agencies only  
9 in investigating or responding to reports of child abuse,  
10 neglect, or exploitation”.
