5 (a) TARGETED PILOT PROGRAM.—The Secretary of
6 Labor shall establish a pilot program pursuant to section
7 171 of the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 (29 U.S.C.
8 2916) to provide grants to entities eligible under such sec-

1 tion to provide job skills training to and specific for older
2 individuals, particularly in the areas of computer literacy,
3 advanced computer operations, and resume writing.

4 (b) DEFINITION.—For purposes of the program es-
5 tablished under subsection (a), the term “older individual”
6 has the meaning given that term in section 101 of the
7 Workforce Investment Act of 1998 (29 U.S.C. 2801).
