To permit each current member of the Board of Directors of the Office of Compliance to serve for 3 terms.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ADDITIONAL TERM FOR MEMBERS OF BOARD**
4 **OF DIRECTORS OF OFFICE OF COMPLIANCE.**

5 Notwithstanding the second sentence of section
6 301(e)(1) of the Congressional Accountability Act of 1995
7 (2 U.S.C. 1381(e)(1)), any individual serving as a member
8 of the Board of Directors of the Office of Compliance as
9 of September 30, 2009, may serve for 3 terms.
