AN ACT

- To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to extend telehealth flexibilities under the Medicare program, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
2	This Act may be cited as the "Advancing Telehealth
3	Beyond COVID–19 Act of 2022".
4	SEC. 2. REMOVING GEOGRAPHIC REQUIREMENTS AND EX-
5	PANDING ORIGINATING SITES FOR TELE-
6	HEALTH SERVICES.
7	Section $1834(m)$ of the Social Security Act (42)
8	U.S.C. 1395m(m)) is amended—
9	(1) in paragraph (2)(B)(iii)—
10	(A) by striking "With" and inserting "In
11	the case that the emergency period described in
12	section $1135(g)(1)(B)$ ends before December
13	31, 2024, with"; and
14	(B) by striking "that are furnished during
15	the 151-day period beginning on the first day
16	after the end of the emergency period described
17	in section $1135(g)(1)(B)$ " and inserting "that
18	are furnished during the period beginning on
19	the first day after the end of such emergency
20	period and ending December 31, 2024"; and
21	(2) in paragraph $(4)(C)(iii)$ —
22	(A) by striking "With" and inserting "In
23	the case that the emergency period described in
24	section $1135(g)(1)(B)$ ends before December
25	31, 2024, with"; and

(B) by striking "that are furnished during
the 151-day period beginning on the first day
after the end of the emergency period described
in section 1135(g)(1)(B)" and inserting "that
are furnished during the period beginning on
the first day after the end of such emergency
period and ending on December 31, 2024".

8 SEC. 3. EXPANDING PRACTITIONERS ELIGIBLE TO FUR9 NISH TELEHEALTH SERVICES.

10 Section 1834(m)(4)(E) of the Social Security Act (42) U.S.C. 1395m(m)(4)(E)) is amended by striking "and, for 11 12 the 151-day period beginning on the first day after the end of the emergency period described in section 13 1135(g)(1)(B)" and inserting "and, in the case that the 14 15 emergency period described in section 1135(g)(1)(B) ends before December 31, 2024, for the period beginning on 16 the first day after the end of such emergency period and 17 18 ending on December 31, 2024".

19 SEC. 4. EXTENDING TELEHEALTH SERVICES FOR FEDER-

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ALLY QUALIFIED HEALTH CENTERS AND RURAL HEALTH CLINICS.

Section 1834(m)(8)(A) of the Social Security Act (42
U.S.C. 1395m(m)(8)(A)) is amended by striking "during
the 151-day period beginning on the first day after the
end of such emergency period" and inserting "in the case

that such emergency period ends before December 31,
 2024, during the period beginning on the first day after
 the end of such emergency period and ending on December
 31, 2024".

5 SEC. 5. DELAYING THE IN-PERSON REQUIREMENTS UNDER 6 MEDICARE FOR MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES 7 FURNISHED THROUGH TELEHEALTH AND 8 TELECOMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGY.

9 (a) Delay IN REQUIREMENTS FOR MENTAL 10 HEALTH SERVICES FURNISHED THROUGH TELE-HEALTH.—Section 1834(m)(7)(B)(i) of the Social Secu-11 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395m(m)(7)(B)(i)) is amended, in 12 the matter preceding subclause (I), by striking "on or 13 after the day that is the 152nd day after the end of the 14 15 period at the end of the emergency sentence described in section 1135(g)(1)(B))" and inserting "on or after Janu-16 ary 1, 2025 (or, if later, the first day after the end of 17 described 18 the emergency period in section 19 1135(g)(1)(B))".

20 (b) MENTAL HEALTH VISITS FURNISHED BY RURAL
21 HEALTH CLINICS.—Section 1834(y) of the Social Security
22 Act (42 U.S.C. 1395m(y)) is amended—

23 (1) in the heading, by striking "TO HOSPICE
24 PATIENTS"; and

(2) in paragraph (2), by striking "prior to the
 day that is the 152nd day after the end of the emer gency period described in section 1135(g)(1)(B))"
 and inserting "prior to January 1, 2025 (or, if later,
 the first day after the end of the emergency period
 described in section 1135(g)(1)(B))".

7 (c) MENTAL HEALTH VISITS FURNISHED BY FEDER8 ALLY QUALIFIED HEALTH CENTERS.—Section
9 1834(o)(4) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
10 1395m(o)(4) is amended—

(1) in the heading, by striking "TO HOSPICE
PATIENTS"; and

13 (2) in subparagraph (B), by striking "prior to 14 the day that is the 152nd day after the end of the 15 emergency period described in section 1135(g)(1)(B))" and inserting "prior to January 1, 16 17 2025 (or, if later, the first day after the end of the 18 emergency period described in section 19 1135(g)(1)(B))".

20 SEC. 6. ALLOWING FOR THE FURNISHING OF AUDIO-ONLY 21 TELEHEALTH SERVICES.

Section 1834(m)(9) of the Social Security Act (42
U.S.C. 1395m(m)(9)) is amended by striking "The Secretary shall continue to provide coverage and payment
under this part for telehealth services identified in para-

1 graph (4)(F)(i) as of the date of the enactment of this 2 paragraph that are furnished via an audio-only tele-3 communications system during the 151-day period begin-4 ning on the first day after the end of the emergency period 5 described in section 1135(g)(1)(B)" and inserting "In the 6 case that the emergency period described in section 7 1135(g)(1)(B) ends before December 31, 2024, the Sec-8 retary shall continue to provide coverage and payment 9 under this part for telehealth services identified in paragraph (4)(F)(i) that are furnished via an audio-only com-10 munications system during the period beginning on the 11 12 first day after the end of such emergency period and ending on December 31, 2024". 13

14 SEC. 7. USE OF TELEHEALTH TO CONDUCT FACE-TO-FACE

15 ENCOUNTER PRIOR TO RECERTIFICATION OF 16 ELIGIBILITY FOR HOSPICE CARE DURING 17 EMERGENCY PERIOD.

18 Section 1814(a)(7)(D)(i)(II) of the Social Security 19 Act (42 U.S.C. 1395f(a)(7)(D)(i)(II)) is amended by 20 striking "and during the 151-day period beginning on the 21 first day after the end of such emergency period" and in-22 serting "and, in the case that such emergency period ends 23 before December 31, 2024, during the period beginning 24 on the first day after the end of such emergency period described in such section 1135(g)(1)(B) and ending on
 December 31, 2024".

3 SEC. 8. FUNDING FROM MEDICARE IMPROVEMENT FUND.

4 Section 1898(b)(1) of the Social Security Act (42
5 U.S.C. 1395jjj(b)(1)) is amended by striking
6 "\$7,500,000,000" and inserting "\$5,153,000,000".

7 SEC. 9. PROGRAM INSTRUCTION AUTHORITY.

8 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-9 retary of Health and Human Services may implement the 10 provisions of, including amendments made by, sections 2 11 through 7 through program instruction or otherwise.

12 SEC. 10. DETERMINATION OF BUDGETARY EFFECTS.

13 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of 14 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010, 15 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement 16 titled "Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation" for this 17 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record 18 by the Chairman of the House Budget Committee, pro-19 vided that such statement has been submitted prior to the 20 vote on passage.
