## A BILL

# SECTION 1. RESTORATION OF VETERAN PLOT ALLOWANCE ELIGIBILITY AND HEADSTONE OR MARKER ALLOWANCE.

4 (a) RESTORATION OF PLOT ALLOWANCE ELIGI5 BILITY FOR VETERANS OF ANY WAR.—Section 2303(b)
6 of title 38, United States Code, is amended—

7 (1) in the matter preceding paragraph (1), by 8 striking "subsection (a) of this section" and all that follows through "and who" and inserting the fol-9 10 lowing: "subsection (a), in the case of a veteran who 11 is eligible for a burial allowance under such sub-12 section or under section 2302 of this title, who was 13 discharged from the active military, naval, or air 14 service for a disability incurred or aggravated in the 15 line of duty, or who is a veteran of any war and"; 16 and

17 (2) in paragraph (2)—

(A) by striking "is eligible for a burial allowance under section 2302 of this title or
under subsection (a) of this section, or was discharged from the active military, naval, or air
service for a disability incurred or aggravated in
line of duty, and such veteran"; and

24 (B) by striking "clause (1) of this sub25 section" and inserting "paragraph (1)".

(b) RESTORATION OF HEADSTONE OR MARKER AL LOWANCE.—

3 (1) ALLOWANCE.—Section 2306 of title 38,
4 United States Code, is amended by adding at the
5 end the following new subsection:

"(h) In lieu of furnishing a headstone or marker 6 7 under subsection (a)(2) or (b), the Secretary, in the Secretary's discretion, having due regard for the cir-8 9 cumstances in each case, may reimburse the person enti-10 tled to request such headstone or marker for the cost of acquiring a non-Government headstone or marker for 11 placement in any cemetery other than a national cemetery 12 in connection with the burial or memorialization of the de-13 ceased individual.". 14

15 (2) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Subsection (g)
16 of such section is amended by adding at the end the
17 following new paragraph:

18 "(4) Reimbursement may not be provided under sub-19 section (h) for the cost of acquiring a non-Government 20 headstone or marker in connection with the burial or me-21 morialization of a person described in section 2411(b) of 22 this title.".

23 (3) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—Subsection (a) of
24 such section is amended by moving the margin of

each of paragraphs (1) through (5) by two ems to
 the right.

3 (4) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made
4 by this subsection shall apply with respect to deaths
5 occurring on or after the date of the enactment of
6 this Act.
