3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Opioid Immediate Sus-
5 pension Order Act of 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. DEFINITION OF IMMINENT DANGER TO THE PUBLIC**
2 **HEALTH OR SAFETY FOR PURPOSES OF SUS-**
3 **PENDING A REGISTRATION.**

7 and inserting “(d) The Attorney General”; and
8 (2) by striking paragraph (2).

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
