### A BILL

  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

### 3 SECTION 1. STATUE OF "THE UNKNOWN SLAVE".

4 Not later than 180 days after the date of the enact5 ment of this Act, the Architect of the Capitol (hereafter
6 in this Act referred to as the "Architect") shall solicit bids
7 and enter into an agreement for the creation of a statue
8 of "The Unknown Slave". The Architect shall acquire and

permanently display that statue in Emancipation Hall in
 the Capitol Visitor Center.

# 3 SEC. 2. CONSULTATION WITH CONGRESSIONAL BLACK 4 CAUCUS.

5 The Architect shall carry out this Act in consultation6 with the Congressional Black Caucus.
