Mr. WALZ (for himself and Mr. GIBSON) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to eliminate the age restriction on the commencement of the receipt of retired pay for non-regular service.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Support America’s
5 Armed Forces Reserve Component Retirees Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF AGE RESTRICTION ON COM-**
7 **MENCEMENT OF RECEIPT OF RETIRED PAY**
8 **FOR NON-REGULAR SERVICE.**

9 (a) ELIMINATION OF ELIGIBILITY AGE.—Section
10 12731(a)(1) of title 10, United States Code, is amended

1 by striking “person;” and inserting “person, except that,
2 in the case of any person who first enters a uniformed
3 service on or after January 1, 2018, this paragraph shall
4 not apply;”.

5 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT RELATING TO COM-
6 PUTATION OF RETIRED PAY BASE.—Section 1407(d)(4)
7 of title 10, United States Code, is amended by adding at
8 the end the following new sentence: “In the case of a mem-
9 ber or former member who first became a member on or
10 after January 1, 2018, and whose retired pay is covered
11 by paragraph (1) or (2), the 36 months shall only include
12 months for which the member was entitled to monthly
13 basic pay.”.
