Mr. DENT (for himself and Mr. ASHFORD) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To add support of a foreign terrorist organization to the list of acts for which United States nationals would lose their nationality, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Enemy Expatriation
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. LOSS OF NATIONALITY.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 349(a) of the Immigra-
8 tion and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1481(a)) is amended—

1 (1) in each of paragraphs (1) through (6), by
2 striking “or” at the end;

3 (2) in paragraph (7), by striking the period at
4 the end and inserting “; or”; and

5 (3) by adding at the end the following:

6 “(8) traveling abroad to join, participate in,
7 train with, fight for, conspire with, or otherwise sup-
8 port a foreign terrorist organization designated by
9 the Secretary of State under section 219.”.

10 (b) TECHNICAL AMENDMENT.—Section 351(a) of the
11 Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1483(a)) is
12 amended by striking “(6) and (7)” and inserting “(6), (7),
13 and (8)”.

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
