To amend title 5, United States Code, to extend the period
of certain authority with respect to judicial review of
Merit Systems Protection Board decisions relating to
whistleblowers, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “All Circuit Review Ex-
5 tension Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. JUDICIAL REVIEW OF MERIT SYSTEMS PROTECTION**
2 **BOARD DECISIONS RELATING TO WHISTLE-**
3 **BLOWERS.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 7703(b)(1)(B) of title 5,
5 United States Code, is amended by striking “2-year” and
6 inserting “5-year”.

7 (b) **DIRECTOR REVIEW.**—Section 7703(d)(2) of such
8 title is amended by striking “2-year” and inserting “5-
9 year”.
