3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Securing Comprehen-
5 sive Review in Entry Enforcement Now Act of 2019” or
6 the “SCREEN Act of 2019”.

1 **SEC. 2. OFFICERS OF U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTEC-**
2 **TION AUTHORIZED TO CONDUCT ASYLUM**
3 **INTERVIEWS.**

4 Section 235(b)(1)(E) of the Immigration and Nation-
5 ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1225(b)(1)(E)) is amended in the mat-
6 ter preceding clause (i), by inserting “, including an officer
7 of U.S. Customs and Border Protection,” after “immigra-
8 tion officer”.

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
