A BILL

To amend the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 to provide for discretionary spending limits for each of fiscal years 2026 through 2029, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Enforce the Caps Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. DISCRETIONARY SPENDING LIMITS FOR FISCAL**
2 **YEARS 2026 THROUGH 2029.**

3 Section 251(c) of the Balanced Budget and Emer-
4 gency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (2 U.S.C. 901(c)), as
5 amended by the Fiscal Responsibility Act of 2023, is fur-
6 ther amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (9)(B), by striking “and” at
8 the end; and

9 (2) by inserting after paragraph (10) the fol-
10 lowing:

11 “(11) for fiscal year 2026, for the discretionary
12 category, \$1,621,959,000,000 in new budget author-
13 ity;

14 “(12) for fiscal year 2027, for the discretionary
15 category, \$1,638,179,000,000 in new budget author-
16 ity;

17 “(13) for fiscal year 2028, for the discretionary
18 category, \$1,654,560,000,000 in new budget author-
19 ity; and

20 “(14) for fiscal year 2029, for the discretionary
21 category, \$1,671,106,000,000 in new budget author-
22 ity;”.
