Mr. TAKANO (for himself and Mr. FLORES) introduced the following bill;
which was referred to the Committee on Education and the Workforce

A BILL

To require institutions of higher education to disseminate information with respect to the completion rates, employment rates, and retention rates of recipients of GI Bill funding.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Veterans Education
5 Outcomes Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. INFORMATION DISSEMINATION WITH RESPECT TO**
2 **RECIPIENTS OF GI BILL FUNDING.**

3 Section 485(a) of the Higher Education Act of 1965
4 (20 U.S.C. 1092) is amended—

5 (1) in paragraph (1)(Q)—

6 (A) in clause (iii), by striking “and”; and

7 (B) by adding “and” at the end of clause
8 (iv); and

9 (C) by adding at the end the following:

10 “(v) are recipients of educational as-
11 sistance provided under chapter 30 or 33
12 of title 38, United States Code, or chapter
13 1606 of title 10, United States Code;”;
14 and

15 (2) by adding at the end the following:

16 “(8) The information disseminated under sub-
17 paragraphs (E), (L), (R), (S), and (U) of paragraph
18 (1) shall be disaggregated by the recipients of edu-
19 cational assistance provided under chapter 30 or 33
20 of title 38, United States Code, or chapter 1606 of
21 title 10, United States Code, if the number of stu-
22 dents in such subgroup is sufficient to yield statis-
23 tically reliable information and reporting will not re-
24 veal personally identifiable information about an in-
25 dividual student. If such number is not sufficient for
26 such purposes, then the institution shall note that

1 the institution enrolled too few of such students to
2 so disclose or report with confidence and confiden-
3 tiality.”.

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
