A BILL

To repeal certain incentives and subsidies for renewable fuels.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Remove Incentives for
- 5 Producing Ethanol Act of 2011" or the "RIPE Act of6 2011".

7 SEC. 2. REPEAL OF RENEWABLE FUEL STANDARD.

- 8 Section 211(o) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.
- 9 7545(0)) is repealed.

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3 Sections 6426(b)(6) and 6427(e)(6)(A) of the Inter4 nal Revenue Code of 1986 are each amended by striking
5 "December 31, 2011" and inserting "the date of the en6 actment of the RIPE Act of 2011".

7 SEC. 4. IMMEDIATE TERMINATION OF INCOME TAX CREDIT 8 FOR ALCOHOL USED AS FUEL.

9 Paragraph (1) of section 40(e) of the Internal Rev10 enue Code of 1986 is amended by striking "any sale or
11 use—" and all that follows and inserting "any sale or use
12 for any period after the date of the enactment of the RIPE
13 Act of 2011.".

14 SEC. 5. REMOVAL OF TARIFFS ON ETHANOL.

(a) DUTY-FREE TREATMENT.—Chapter 98 of the
Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
amended by adding at the end the following new subchapter:

6 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
7 this section apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from
8 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
9 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
