1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Service Provider Op-3 portunity Clarification Act of 2015".

4 SEC. 2. GOOD FAITH COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIRE5 MENTS OF PRIME CONTRACTORS WITH RE6 SPECT TO SUBCONTRACTING PLANS.

7 Not later than 270 days after the date of enactment 8 of this Act, the Administrator of the Small Business Ad-9 ministration shall issue regulations providing examples of activities that would be considered a failure to make a 10 11 good faith effort to comply with the requirements imposed 12 on an entity (other than a small business concern as defined under section 3 of the Small Business Act (15 13 U.S.C. 632)) that is awarded a prime contract containing 14 the clauses required under paragraphs (4) or (5) of section 15 16 8(d) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 637(d)).
