A BILL

To provide grants for the renovation, modernization, and construction of law enforcement facilities.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Protect Those Who
- 5 Serve Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.
- 7 In this Act:
- 8 (1) Law enforcement facility.—The term
- 9 "law enforcement facility" means any building or fa-
- cility that serves as an official work site for State or

- local public safety officers that have law enforcement
 standing.
- 3 (2) STATE.—The term "State" means each of
- 4 the several States, the District of Columbia, the
- 5 Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, the Commonwealth
- 6 of the Northern Mariana Islands, American Samoa,
- 7 Guam, the Virgin Islands, any territory or posses-
- 8 sion of the United States, and any Indian tribe.

9 SEC. 3. GRANTS.

- 10 The Attorney General is authorized to make grants
- 11 to States for the renovation, modernization, and construc-
- 12 tion of law enforcement facilities.

13 SEC. 4. MATCHING REQUIREMENT.

- 14 (a) MATCHING REQUIREMENT.—As a condition of re-
- 15 ceiving funding under a grant awarded under section 3,
- 16 with respect to the renovation, modernization, or construc-
- 17 tion of a law enforcement facility, the following matching
- 18 requirements shall apply:
- 19 (1) In the case of a law enforcement facility
- that serves a population of 50,000 or more, the fa-
- 21 cility shall agree to match the Federal grant funds
- with an amount of non-Federal funds equal to 20
- percent of the total project cost.
- 24 (2) In the case of a law enforcement facility
- 25 that serves a population of more than 20,000 but

- 1 fewer than 50,000, the facility shall agree to match
- 2 the Federal grant funds with an amount of non-Fed-
- 3 eral funds equal to 10 percent of the total project
- 4 cost.
- 5 (3) In the case of a law enforcement facility
- 6 that serves a population of 20,000 or fewer, the fa-
- 7 cility shall agree to match the Federal grant funds
- 8 with an amount of non-Federal funds equal to 5 per-
- 9 cent of the total project cost.
- 10 (b) REGIONAL COST-SHARE.—In the case of a facility
- 11 to be operated by a geographic region, the matching re-
- 12 quirement under subsection (a) applicable to such facility
- 13 shall be determined based on the total population and de-
- 14 mographics of the entire region.

15 SEC. 5. ADMINISTRATION.

- 16 The Attorney General shall prescribe requirements,
- 17 including application requirements, for grants under the
- 18 program under this Act.

19 SEC. 6. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

- There are authorized to be appropriated to carry out
- 21 this Act \$500,000,000 for each of the fiscal years 2010
- 22 through 2015.
