- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Renewable Energy
- 5 Production Tax Credit Extension Act of 2009".
- 6 SEC. 2. 5-YEAR EXTENSION OF CREDIT FOR ELECTRICITY
- 7 PRODUCED FROM CERTAIN RENEWABLE RE-
- 8 SOURCES.
- 9 Section 45(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986
- 10 (relating to qualified facilities) is amended—

1	(1) by striking "2010" each place it appears in
2	paragraphs (1) and (8) and inserting "2015",
3	(2) by striking "2011" each place it appears in
4	paragraphs (2), (3), (4), (5), (6), (7) and (9) and
5	inserting "2016", and
6	(3) by striking "2012" in paragraph (11)(B)
7	and inserting "2017".

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
