Mr. BUCHANAN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To direct the Comptroller General of the United States to conduct a study on the potential inclusion of black box data recorders in tactical vehicles of the Armed Forces.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Data Recorders In-
5 stalled in Vehicles Equipped So Armed Forces Endure
6 Act” or the “DRIVE SAFE Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. STUDY AND REPORT ON POTENTIAL INCLUSION OF**
2 **BLACK BOX DATA RECORDERS IN TACTICAL**
3 **VEHICLES.**

4 (a) STUDY.—The Comptroller General of the United
5 States shall conduct a study to evaluate the feasibility and
6 advisability of equipping all tactical vehicles of the Armed
7 Forces with black box data recorders.

8 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date
9 of the enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General shall
10 submit to the congressional defense committees a report
11 on the results of the study conducted under subsection (a).

12 (c) CONGRESSIONAL DEFENSE COMMITTEES DE-
13 FINED.—In this Act, the term “congressional defense
14 committees” has the meaning given that term in section
15 101(a)(16) of title 10, United States Code.
